UFV REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Language Requirements	As the teaching language at UFV is Spanish a B1 level is required. All non-native Spanish students will be asked to complete a Spanish level test , in order to facilitate their course selection. <i>More information will be sent upon successful completion of our online application.</i> English-taught courses require an English B2 level , and are only available in modules of Business Administration, International Relations, Gastronomy and Biotechnology. Only students from universities with an agreement in these specific areas can enrol in these modules. Yet, we cannot guarantee spots for all students.
Intensive/ Semester-long Spanish Language Courses	Intensive Spanish Course (3/4 ECTS) is available before the semester starts. <i>More information about fees and details will be sent upon successful completion of our online application.</i> Fall Semester: August 28 th – September 8 th 2017 (4 ECTS) Spring Semester: January 8 th – January 13 th 2018 (3 ECTS) Semester-long Spanish Course (6 ECTS) All levels (basic/medium/advanced) available for free to all international students. <i>*Please note that you have to complete a Spanish level test. More Information will be sent upon successful completion of the online application.</i>



Health Insurance Requirements	EU students must have the European Health Insurance Card or any other equivalent private insurance including conditions. Non-EU students must have a private insurance including repatriation of remains. <i>Without insurance students will not be enrolled.</i>
VISA	Documentation for non-EU students: Passport and Visa. <i>Students must bring a copy of their Visa to the Orientation Session.</i>
