TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS:

Transcripts are first sent to students by email and then to home university by post. They are issued within 5 weeks after the end of exams.

HEALTH INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:

EU and EEA citizens must bring European Health Insurance Card issued in the home country.

NON-EEA citizens must purchase an adequate insurance policy valid in Lithuania for the entire period of stay. LCC International University requires all international students to purchase local insurance, which costs around 70 EUR. The insurance fee is added to your student bill. We also recommend that you seek additional insurance since the one provided through LCC International University is minimal.

VISA:

Not required for EU and EEA citizens.

NON-EEA citizens in order to legally study and stay in Lithuania need to acquire a National Visa D prior entering the country. Our Migration Office will provide you with all the necessary visa documents, but you will be responsible for covering the visa fee and setting up an appointment at the Lithuanian embassy in your home country.
