Nomination ( <i>new procedure</i> )	Partner Universities will have to fill out the <a href="#">online nomination form</a> . ISD will confirm the nomination by email.
Application Procedure	Students need to <a href="#">apply online</a> and upload the required documents (see link).
Nomination period	<b>Winter semester:</b> 1 February - 15 May <b>Spring semester:</b> 1 February - <b>15 October</b>
Application period	<b>Winter semester:</b> 1 February - 1 June <b>Spring semester:</b> 1 February - <b>1 November</b>
Application deadline for students from <b>Pakistan, Bangladesh and Nepal</b>	<b>Winter Semester:</b> 1 April <b>Spring Semester:</b> 1 October
Semester dates	<b>Winter Semester (WS):</b> September – February <b>Spring Semester (SS):</b> February – July The <a href="#">academic calendar</a> can be found here.
Welcome Day	At the start of each semester we organise a <a href="#">Welcome Day</a> for all new international students. On this day students will receive information about important practical matters. Accepted students will receive an invitation by email. For students with a non-European nationality we also organise a <a href="#">Pre-Welcome Day</a> . Both days are not mandatory, but are highly recommended!
Language of instruction	The language of instruction for all our exchange programmes is English.
English language requirements	Exchange students are not required to submit proof of their English proficiency. Partner institutions are expected to select students who have a good standard of English (minimum of B1)
Possibility of attending courses from different departments	Students can only apply for an exchange programme of the <i>Schools</i> as stated in the institutional agreement. Most <i>Schools</i> offer fixed semester programmes (30 ECTS). Unfortunately, it is not possible to 'mix and match' courses from different <i>Schools</i> .
Learning Agreements	Learning Agreements will be forwarded by ISD to the departmental coordinator of the <i>School</i> . The <i>School</i> will return the signed document to you a.s.a.p.
Accommodation	Hanze UAS does not offer on-campus accommodation. For more information about <a href="#">housing</a> please check our website.
